



Make Your Own Wildflower Seed Bombs



Supplies you will need:

- blue and green construction paper
- water
- food processor
- wildflower seeds
- 2 bowls
- mini muffin tin




Step 1:

Tear the blue paper into small pieces and place torn paper in bowl, cover with water, to soak for at least 20 minutes. Repeat with the green paper, using another bowl.

Step 2:

When the blue paper is soaked add it to a food processor and whiz it until it is totally broken down into a pulp. Pour blue paper pulp into a bowl. Repeat with the green paper, in another bowl.



Step 3:

Add a layer of the damp pulp to the mini muffin tin. You can combine the colors as you like. Make a base layer of paper pulp.

Step 4:

Sprinkle the wildflower seeds over the paper pulp and add another layer of paper pulp. Use your fingers to press the seeds and pulp into the muffin tin cups.

Step 5:

Set aside to dry for a few hours. Then remove from the muffin tin and dry fully on a baking rack.

Step 6:

When ready to plant, toss the wildflower seed bombs into the garden and wait for them to grow!
